During the two days we will have focus on international views on the subject with speakers from Denmark, France and the United States, but we will also hear how the work on the renovation of Drottningholm avenues was undertaken (all international presentations will be in English). Presentations will cover everything from the restoration of an avenue at Fredensborg in Denmark and how the park's trees are managed, how the work in Versailles was implemented when they needed to replant large parts of the park after a major storm hit the park in 1999. We will also follow the renewal of Drottningholm avenue and during day two we will also get the chance to visit the plantations and discuss the ongoing maintenance. Lastly we are very proud that Ed (Edward) Gillman from the University of Florida will do a presentation on

how we should think in terms of pruning of trees, which many times is of great importance for how the trees in the future will be developed.

I am sure that this conference will touch base with many in our industry, and I hope that I will get to meet as many of you as possible during the annual conference. I am also sure there are many in other industry, for example in the National Heritage Board, who will be visiting the conference, which can give a chance to many interesting meetings!
