

Course in :
Advanced Risk Assessment techniques

7-8 of September, Stockholm, Sweden, 2017



This course is meant as one of the Swedish Tree Associations highest level of courses and will help tree managers, arborists and consultant to get an in-depth knowledge on the tools used to investigate trees.

The first day will be theoretical and focus on the advanced risk assessment techniques that are available

and how they can be used. Day two start around 9 AM and continues to around 14 in the afternoon. We will spend the whole day outside in Djurgården where we will dissect trees with different defects and conduct PiCUS and Rinntech drill (Resistograph) measurements.
