

Course in the tree risk assessment system:

TRAQ

Assessment of risk trees is something that's becoming more and more common in the management of trees. For tree managers, consultants and arborists, it's therefore important to know the factors that influence whether a tree should be classified as a risk-trees and the actions that can be taken to reduce the risk.

To be able to increase the knowledge of risk-tree the Swedish Tree Association have for some years offered the TRAQ-course (Tree Risk Assessment Qualification), which is a system for assessing the risk of trees. The TRAQ-course have in a short time become well-known and have now been used in municipal procurements.
